



Hafiz Moulana Syed Naem Ahmed

Hafiz Moulana Syed Naem Ahmed is the seventh child among his five brothers and three sisters.

At the tender age of five he passed his K.G. and class 1 in Bangladesh. He took admission only twelve days before his examinations. He was a number one student and at the top of his studies amongst his peers. After going through various exams he went on to gain a scholarship from the madrasa he was studying at. In 2001 he completed a six month long Arabic language course from Yahya Uttara's Al Islami (Al Kuwait) Higher Institute for Islamic Studies.

Born on October 27th 1978 in the village of Syedpur in Jagannathpur upazilla under Sunamgonj district, Moulana Syed Naem Ahmed started his education in the local Moktab and then in Syedpur Hafiziya Hosainiya Arabiya Darul Hadis Madrasa. In 2000 he passed the Fazil exam and then in 2002 successfully passed the Kamil exam. He went on to become the Hifz –e- Quran in 1990.

On his first visit to the UK Hafiz Moulana Syed Naem Ahmed taught in an educational institution named Mazahirul Uloom Madrasa in Mile End, East London. He is also been a teacher in the Shah Poran Masjid and Islamic centre in Hackney since 2001. At the same time he served as a cleric (Imam) for the Masjid



for a long period of time. Furthermore he has been serving as a teacher in the Imam Zakariya Academy (primary school) since 2004.

Presently Hafiz Moulana Syed Naem Ahmed is the media secretary of Jamiat –e- Ulamaye Islam Europe, joint secretary of the newly formed Islamic Oikya Jote (IOJ) Europe and the organising secretary of the IOJ in the UK branch, he is also the organising secretary for Islamic Aim Bastobayan Committee UK, Literary secretary of Jamiatus Sabab Europe and the secretary general of the International Sirat Committee London. He has been a long serving member of a movement called Chhatra Jamiat since its inception and has been involved in many different ways such as he has been the secretary of Chhatra Jamiat of the Syedpur Regional branch, later he was the information secretary and the

organising secretary of Chhatra Jamiat Jagannathpur Thana Committee.

Whilst in Dhaka in 2001 Moulana Syed Naem Ahmed became the training secretary of the Chhatra Jamiat Dhaka North and executive committee member of Dhaka City. As a student he was also a library secretary of the Students Association in his Madrasa, moreover he also wrote various articles in magazines and was closely associated with some of the big weekly newspapers in Bangladesh like the Muslim Jahan, the Touhidi Porikroma and the Jamiat. He continued this role in London writing for newspapers such as Eurobangla and Notun Din.

Hafiz Moulana Syed Naem Ahmed is married to Farida Khatun Choudhury and they have one daughter.
