



Alhaj Dr. M A Aziz

A well known community leader and philanthropist Alhaj Dr. M A Aziz is currently residing in the Redbridge area of London. He hails from the village of Musapur Union in Companygonj Thana under Noakhali district of Bangladesh. The only son of late Moulvi Abdur Rashid a well known philanthropist of his time.

Dr. M A Aziz started his education from MM Madrassah and studied BA (Hons) in political science. As a meritorious student who passed with distinction and secured the exceptional talent pool in Comilla Board in Bangladesh. He recently obtained a Ph. D. In 1976, he came to United Kingdom to become a Barrister and to devote himself in the legal profession but later he changed his mind.

His ambition was not satisfied by becoming a language and religious teacher and in 1981 he established a printing company to serve the community and to build a closer relationship with expatriate Bangladeshis in United Kingdom. The name of his printing company is 'Languatec' which is an abbreviation of Language and Technology. In the days when the company came into existence there were very few Bengali printers in the community here in Britain.

Through his business he came across various sections of the multilingual community of Britain. His lust for community work did not end there. He is one of the owners of the First and only English week-



ly newspaper the 'Bangla Mirror', which serves the community. He is the editor-in-chief of that newspaper.

Alhaj Dr .M A Aziz is involved with different organisations. He is the Chairperson of Greater Noakhali Association UK, President of Redbridge Bangladeshi Business Forum, Joint Convenor of Bangladesh Flood Prevention International Committee UK, Vice President of UK Bangladesh Nationalist Party, former President of Leyton Islamic Centre and former Treasurer of Finsbury Park Asian Centre in London.

Dr. M A Aziz has travelled widely to different districts of England, Scotland, Ireland and Wales. He has also travelled to European , Asian and American countries including Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, UAE, Qatar, Pakistan, India, Nepal, Singapore, Malaysia, Turkey, France, Germany, Holland, Belgium, Luxemburg, Italy, Switzerland, UAS, Canada and

others.

Wherever he has travelled to he has invited the Bangladeshi community to exchange ideas and views through dialogue. For assisting the Bangladeshi Community with cultural integration he was awarded Channel-S Community Award 2006 and Civic Award 2007.

Among his latest establishment is a Charity Clinic in Musapur, Bangladesh at the cost of one crore taka on 80 decimal of purchased land. He purchased another piece of land about 40 decimal at Basurhat Thana Sodor for other charity work. His mission and vision is to devote himself in social welfare activities through out his life.

Alhaj Dr.M A Aziz is married and blessed with five sons and two daughters. His sons and daughters are studying in different universities and colleges in the United Kingdom.
