



## Mr Enamul Munim Shamim Ludhi

**B**orn in 1967, into an a respectable Muslim family, the eldest son of Abdul Munim Ludhi and Syeda Monowara Akhtar, in the village of Mathiura, Beanibazar in the district of Sylhet, Bangladesh. Mr E M Ludhi studied at the Central Mathiura Govt Primary School, Mathiura High School, the Aided High School and Murari Chad College (MC College) in Sylhet. In December 1985 he came to London, he then got admitted at Westminster College where he studied.

In 1987 he started work with a catering business, with in a few years, he became a self employed businessman and opened a number of restaurants, now he is a well established businessman who specialises in the land and property development, buy-to-let investment in the UK and Bangladesh, and is also in the retailing business. As well as being a busy and successful business man, he also finds the time to participate in many community activities, and is involved in many charitable organisations, he has done and continues to do a lot of charity work.

He served as a joint secretary "Shahiedgha Probashi Sommittee" UK (1995-97). In addition, he was the joint secretary of Maithura Colleget School Development Committee UK (1994). He then served as the membership secretary of "Beanibazar Welfare Trust" UK (2000-2003). Then during 2004-2007 he was the Health and Welfare Secretary of "Beanibazar Welfare Trust" UK. Since 2005 he has been the treasurer of "Beanibazar Jonokollan Sommittee" UK.

He is also a valuable fundraiser and donator, raising money for numerous causes. In 2004 he served as the convenor of "Beanibazar Welfare Trust", "Beanibazar Jonokollan Sommittee" and "Flood Relief Fund Committee" and he and his fellow committee members raised more than £10000 for the flood victims in Beanibazar.

In 2005 he was the convenor of the "Tube Well Fund Raise Committee", raised around £9000 and distributed 110 tube wells for the poor and the needy in Mathiura.



In 2006 he was the convenor of the "Bus Donation Fundraise Committee" and he and his fellow committee members raised £15000 to go to the cause of supplying busses for the students at Beanibazar Women's College. And in 2007 thirty five computer have been donated to all the Beani Bazar secondary school by Beani Bazar Welfare Trust. Shamim Ludhi also donated and worked hard helping committee for fund raising for the that project. As well as doing all of this, he is a regular helper in all community charities and so on, he is a key member of the community and is always participating and aiming to help the Bengali and British community and the poor people in Bangladesh.

His roles in the United Kingdom and Bangladesh include being Founder & Chairman of the Farhana Memorial Trust as well as Patron of Sylhet Academy UK and Europe and Muslim Shaito Shangshad Sylhet. Moreover Mr Ludhi is the Founder Trustee of Beanibazar Welfare Trust UK in addition to being Corporate Member of Jalalabad Oando Kollan Sommittee, Sylhet Bangladesh. Mr Shamim Ludhi is a life member of Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (Sylhet Unit). He is also a member of the Bangladesh British Chamber of Commerce.
