




## Dr M G Moula Miah MIH

**B**orn in 1964 under Rajnagar upazilla in Moulvibazar Bangladesh, Dr. Moula Miah came to the UK at the age of 16 after finishing his secondary school education. Once he had arrived, he went to college on a part time basis and achieved a national diploma in Business Studies. He then worked alongside his father in their own business of manufacturing traditional clothing's. However, Dr. Moula seemed to grow his own motivated passion, this being to bring about Bangladeshi Cuisines creatively to the British people. And soon, he turned this dream into reality, with much hard work and determination; he officially launched his first multi-award winning restaurant Rajnagar in 1987 and followed by a successful Group of Restaurants, as well as residential hotels and land and property development business in the UK and abroad. Since then, he has won and been recommended for many awards including the Centec Business Enterprise investor in people award, Michelin Guide Highly Recommended for the last thirteen years, 5 star National Dome Top 30 Restaurants for seventeen consecutive years. Alongside this, Dr. Moula was also in part time education and in the year 2005, he had finally received his doctorate in Business Management.

Dr. Moula has also helped many charities across the UK and Bangladesh. He has funded for many institutions and infrastructure building on top of offering scholarships to talented students, in Bangladesh. Currently he is working on projects to help bring about jobs for local village people in Bangladesh including: building shopping malls, manufacturing industries and living quarters for the financially handicapped people. By being a director of Hotel White Pearl in Dhaka, the proprietor of the East West Trading Corporation and the proprietor of 'Jonoprothasha', a weekly published newspaper in Moulvibazar, he has opened up opportunities of work for those who were otherwise unemployed in Bangladesh. He also promotes learning the English language by providing a grammar book called "A Complete English Grammar" published by him free



of cost to different school libraries.

Moreover, Dr. Moula is involved with the Bangladeshi community welfare. At the moment, he is the Chairman of Rajnagar International Group of Businesses and East West Trading Corporation UK and Bangladesh, Chairman of Dr Moula foundation, founder of Rajnagar degree college masjid; Bahadurganj Furkania masjid and madrasa complex, President and Founder of the Guild of Bangladeshi Restaurateurs and Moulvibazar Zilla Jonoseba Sangstha, both in the West Midlands, UK, Vice President of Rajnagar Youth Welfare Society UK, Co-founder of Mohan Lal High School and Choudhury Bazaar Masjid, Executive and Life member of the Red Crescent society, former senior vice president Bangladesh welfare association Birmingham, life member Moulvibazar and London Bangla Press Club, Member Of The Institute Of Hospitality to name a few.

Dr. Moula is always up for giving to charity. He has helped in organizing events for all sorts of charities, such as the Alzheimer's Society UK, CRP in Bangladesh, international natural disasters such as the Tsunami and the many Bangladesh Floods and Cyclone appeals and many other charity organisations.
