



## Mr Moulana Sadiqur Rahman

**M**r Moulana Sadiqur Rahman was born in Safdar Manjil of Village Away Golapgonj in the Sylhet district of Bangladesh in 1964. His father is the late Alhaj Nobab Ali and his mother late Salima Khatun.

Mr Rahman started his education at Bohogram Primary School. He then studied Ilmul Ohi at the historical Islamic institution Jameya Islamiya Darul Uloom Deulgram. One he completed this, he studied Jameyatul Wajjan in Malibag, Dhaka. He completed a Titel degree in 1988 at the well respected Jameya Madaniya Kajirbazar Madrahsha in Sylhet.

His professional life began in the Jameya Madaniya Kajirbazar Madrahsha and Jameya Islamia Darul Uloom Deulgram Madrahsha as a teacher.

While in Bangladesh, he was an important figure in movements such as Sylhet Bighag Andolon Movement and was a voice for the



nation.

He is also the founder of the Al Amin Juba Sangha of Gulapgonj and has been the president of this organisation several times. He was also the joint secretary of Sylhet Bibagh Unnayan O' Probashi Kallyan Parishad in 1998. He has also been the chairman of the Islamic Chetana Bastobayan Parishad and one of the leaders of the Islamic Oikya Jote UK.

In the UK, Mr Rahman was integral in establishing the Islamic Teachers Association UK and was elected as the Secretary of this in

2006. He is the General Secretary of the Ulama Mashaikh Parishad UK. He is new elected chairperosn of Association of Islamic Teachers UK.

He established the Alhaj Nobab Ali Welfare Trust in honour of his father, and this organisation helps the poor. This group also helps to distribute funds and aid to those who need it in times of difficulty in Bangladesh.

Mr Rahman is married to Mosammat Sufiya Khatun in 1990, and they have three children—Sajedatur Rahman, Jakwan Hossain and Shakir Hossain.
