Mr Qumor Uddin was born in 1945 in Shenapoti Bari, Nali Uri, Bhadeswar Golapganj, to the late Mr Rais Ali and Mrs Atiba Khanom.

Mr Uddin completed his Secondary education in Nosir Uddin High School in Bhadeswar. After which he went onto MC College in Sylhet where he completed the HSC. Mr Uddin obtained a BSc degree from the prestigious Dhaka University, where he studied mathematics. Whilst in the UK he also obtained a further qualification, namely an NVQ Level 3 in Computing and Maths from London Guildhall University as it was known then.

Mr Uddin's previous employment includes being assistant teacher in Dhaka Dakshin Multi-lateral high

school, Sylhet, where he taught maths from 1964 to 1993. It was in 1993 that he arrived in the UK, where he began teaching Maths and Bangla privately as a home Tutor.

In addition to teaching children of various ages here in the UK. Mr Uddin also has a farm and fishery Bangladesh as well as a Nursery, land and investments as well as a transportation business. These businesses are looked after by one of his thirteen children, all of whom are educated up to at least degree level. Amongst his children, one is a Doctor, and others also occupied with various professions. His children reside in England and also in the United States of America. Four of his children continue to study here in the UK.

Mr Qumor Uddin has also donated very generously to charity. In Bangladesh he is the chairperson of a hospital, which he has funded along with others in his local area in Bangladesh. Moreover he has donated to mosques, madrasas, schools and colleges in his home village.
