Mr. Doros Ullah was born in 1963 at the village of Sherpur under Jagannathpur Upazilla Sunamgonj district. He is the fifth child to his late parents. Mr Ullah came to the UK in 1973 when he was studying his primary education in Bhabanipur Primary School.

After coming to the UK Mr Ullah joined Aston Junior School, and then Aston Manor Secondary School in Birmingham. Later in 1977 he went to Broadway Secondary School in Birmingham. Mr. Doros Ullah later went on to complete his A Levels from Mathew Bolton College and also studied in Sutton Coldfield College until 1985.

Doros Ullah finally graduated in 1988 from South Bank University in London. He joined the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham in 1989 where he was the Health and Safety Officer for ten years. After getting a promotion he

served as the Principal Health and Safety Officer. At his time there Mr Ullah completed many training courses and gained a full membership of the Institute of Occupational Safety and Health. However in 2000 he left that position to join politics full time as an active member. Within a short period of time Doros Ullah was elected as a Councillor in the ward of Whitechapel under the London Borough of Tower Hamlets in 2002. He later went onto become the Mayor of Tower Hamlets.

Within that time Mr Ullah has been in many different positions within the council including; Chair of the Appeal Committee, Vice Chair of the Licensing and General Services Committee, Member of the Development Committee and also member of the Health and Scrutiny Committee. In 2005 Doros Ullah became the Mayor of Tower Hamlets.

Mr Doros Ullah is the Chair of Harry Gosling Primary School Governing Body and also an active member of many voluntary organisations.

Currently Mr. Doros Ullah is a self employed Healthy and Safety Consultant, primarily undertaking Immigration inspections, Inspection of Premises, plants and sites in Brick Lane East London. He has got a Bachelor of Science degree (BSc Hons) MIOSH.

Mr Doros Ullah is married to Fahima Akhter and they have five sons and one daughter. He enjoys playing football with his sons. His hobbies include reading, watching films, music and he loves to cook, which he occasionally does for the family. He is a very prominent political figure within the Bangladeshi Community in Tower Hamlets and beyond.
